## WHY AM I RECEIVING THIS PACKAGE?

You are receiving this package because a Settlement Agreement was approved on January 12, 2018 by the Manitoba Court of Queen's Bench that settles the class action lawsuit respecting the severe flooding in Manitoba in 2011 that led to the evacuation of and/or adverse conditions endured by members of the Pinaymootang (Fairford), Little Saskatchewan, Lake St. Martin, and Dauphin River First Nations.

## WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

Please read the enclosed **Settlement Approval Notice**, **Claim Form** and **Workshop Information**. The **Settlement Approval Notice** contains instructions on how to file a claim for payment, the filing deadline, and information related to the free claim workshops.

## WORKSHOP REGISTRATION

You have the option to attend a workshop to ask questions on how to complete the claim and/or submit your claim in-person. Visit **www.manitobafloodclassaction.com** to sign up for one of the available dates.

To get the most out of these workshops, please bring copies of documents proving your <u>residency in Manitoba</u> at the time of Flood (Spring 2011) and your <u>Band Membership</u>. If you also plan to make a Special Circumstances claim, then you should also bring documents establishing those losses. The chart below lists examples of acceptable documents.
