ON READING THE CONSENT FILED and upon being advised of an undertaking given by the Defendants Grenville Christian College, Charles Farnsworth and Betty Farnsworth not to make any payment other than the payments referred to in paragraph 3 herein without notice to the plaintiffs, and on HEARING submissions for the Plaintiffs, the Defendants Grenville Christian College, Charles Farnsworth and Betty Farnsworth, no one appearing for the Defendant the Incorporated Synod of the Diocese of Ontario or for the Defendant Mary Haig,

THIS COURT ORDERS that the plaintiffs' motion for the Mareva injunction is 1.

adjourned sine die to permit the cross-examination of Donald Farnsworth, if so advised.

2. THIS COURT ORDERS that the interim injunction of June 27, 2008 is dissolved.

3. THIS COURT ORDERS that Grenville Christian College is at liberty to pay the

obligations set out in paragraph 12 of the Affidavit of Donald Farnsworth sworn the 26th day of

June 2008 and in paragraph 10(ii)-(v) and paragraph 12 of the Affidavit of Donald Farnsworth

sworn the 15th day of April 2009 and any legitimate ongoing business expenses.

4. THIS COURT ORDERS that the proceeds of any sale of the defendant Grenville

Christian College's property shall be held in Trust by Adair Morse LLP subject to the provisions

of paragraphs 3 and 5 herein.

5. THIS COURT ORDERS that Grenville Christian College shall advise the Plaintiffs'

solicitors by notice in writing of any intention to make any payment other than payments referred

to in paragraph 3 above and shall not to make any such payment without affording the Plaintiffs

a reasonable opportunity to have their motion for a Mareva injunction heard and disposed of if so

advised.
