Have you paid into the Canada Pension Plan (CPP) and now are disabled from work? You may be entitled to receive CPP Disability Benefits.

The eligibility requirements for receiving CPP Disability Benefits include the following:

- You must have made sufficient contributions to the Canada Pension Plan; and
- You must be suffering from a severe and prolonged disability which prevents you from working regularly.
