Dog Bites

Have you been harmed or attacked by a dog?

While dogs may be our best friends, sometimes they can cause harm. Injuries can be caused by dogs when they bite or attack, but also when they behave in a manner that poses a menace to the safety of persons and other domestic animals.

The owner of a dog is liable for damages resulting from a bite or attack by the dog on another person or domestic animal, under the *Dog Owner's Liability Act*. The liability of the owner does not depend upon knowledge of the propensity of the dog or fault or negligence on the part of the owner. If you or a loved one have been injured by a dog, you have the right to bring a civil claim for compensation for your harms and losses
